## Leading the Way in Safety

We recently took delivery of the latest powered ambulance stretchers from Stryker. The PowerPro2 cot features several upgrades to the previous model, resulting in enhanced safety for both patients and crews, including automatic "best height" setting for wheeling patients, new adjustable features to re-size both ends of the carriage for smaller spaces, and a collapsible pull handle integrated into the foot of the carriage.



As part of a multi-year maintenance and equipment replacement agreement with Stryker, Perinton Ambulance was among the first services in New York State to take delivery of these stretchers. The agreement also ensures we'll continue to lead the way in patient care equipment and safety.
