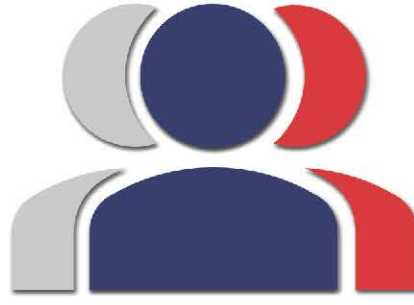


5,956: A record-breaking year!

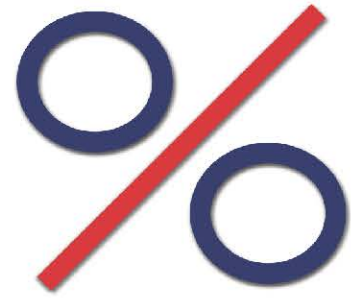
If it seems like you saw more of us last year, you're right! Our crews saw a double-digit increase in call volume over 2021, equal to nearly **two additional calls per day**. Here's some other stats from 2022:



Year-over-year, 2022 resulted in a **13% increase** in call volume. This is the largest annual increase in our history (we usually average about 6%)!



The average ambulance call takes **two hours** to complete. That's equal to 11,912 "people hours" - *or 1.3 years* - caring for patients in 2022.



Our use of lights and siren during patient transport was **about 1% of our call volume**. This means safer travel for our patients, crews, and other drivers.

Monday Night Football game leads to increase in CPR training

By now you must have heard of **Damar Hamlin**, the Buffalo Bills football player who collapsed in front of a national television audience on *Monday Night Football* January 2nd. Thankfully, Damar is on his way to recovery, but each year, over 350,000 aren't as lucky. Too many victims of cardiac arrest don't get the immediate CPR they need...but change may be coming.



Damar's cardiac arrest resulted in a surge of people seeking CPR training nationwide. Locally, the interest in training has been incredible as well. 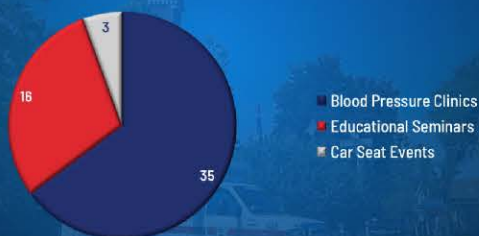

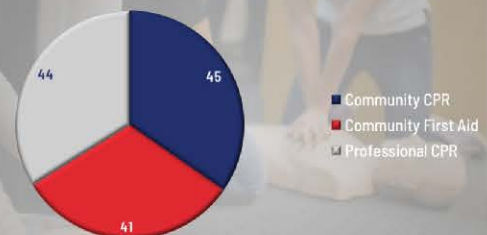
